

How to Disable Warning: Enable Audio Pop-Up in Horizon 8

When accessing a Horizon desktop session using the *Microsoft Edge* browser, users may encounter the following message.

This message is a Warning to click to enable audio with an option for **OK**. If the user clicks **OK** the box will disappear and the session will continue. This is due to security settings within the *Edge* browser. If the user does not want see this message, a browser modification must be made. Below are the steps to complete that modifications to always allow the audio pass through.

How to Allow Autoplay Sound on Edge Computer?

Steps to allow the sound permission and access to play music in the Edge browser on any computer:

- 1. Launch the *Microsoft Edge* browser on Computer.
- 2. Click on ••• menu for options.
- 3. Select **Settings** from the list.
- 4. Switch to the **Cookies and Site Permissions** from the sidebar menu.
- 5. Scroll down and choose the **Media autoplay** option within Site permissions.
- 6. From the drop-down choose the **Allow** option.

This will allow VMWare to use the sound access permissions to play sound and music within the session.
